

AMENDMENTS TO THE SVE BY-LAWS

Change of By-Laws

ARTICLE 6 VOTING

SECTION 6.3.1 is amended as follows:

Current language: For all matters other than the election of Directors that are submitted to a vote of the Members, the Members shall vote by absentee ballot after a special election meeting.

New language: For all matters, other than the election of Directors, that are submitted to a vote of the Members, the Members shall vote by absentee ballot after a *minimum of two (2) special meetings.*

SECTION 6.3.2 is amended as follows:

Current language: Special meetings for the purpose of voting on specific matters(s) will be divided into two sections. The first part shall be a meeting called for the purpose of informing the Membership on the subject(s) to be voted upon. All members wishing to be heard shall have the opportunity to do so during this open meeting. In the second part, after a period of ten (10) days, which will allow adequate time for the Membership to understand the issues(s), the ballots shall be, in a process not inconsistent with the provisions of Articles 6.1 and 6.2, sent out and returned within twenty (20) days. Advocacy notice(s) shall not be included with the ballot in the envelope to be mailed. Ballots shall be tabulated and the results appropriately posted as quickly as possible by an Election Committee formed for this purpose. A majority of the votes cast shall prevail provided a quorum has been attained.

New language: Special meetings for the purpose of voting on specific matters(s) will be divided into two parts. The first part of the meeting shall be for the purpose of informing the Membership on the subject(s) to be voted upon. The second part of said meeting shall be a question and answer period and also to provide Members the opportunity to express their views on the specific matter(s).


After a minimum period of ten (10) days following the second special meeting, the ballots shall be sent out, in a process not inconsistent with the provisions of Articles 6.1 and 6.2, to those entitled to vote pursuant to these bylaws.

The ballot for the special purpose shall inform the Members of a return date and time after which the ballot will not be counted. The said return date shall not be less than thirty (30) days after mailing.

Ballots shall be tabulated and the results posted within five (5) days following the specified return date. The Association office shall also report the voting results in the Association newspaper and on the Association web page. A majority of the votes cast shall prevail provided a quorum has been attained pursuant to Bylaw 5.6.1.

Ballots for voting on special matter(s) may be included with material and ballots mailed to Members for the election of Directors.
