



WHEN YOU ENTER THE LIBRARY YOU ACKNOWLEDGE THAT YOU ARE USING THE FACILITIES AT YOUR OWN RISK. COVID-19 MAY BE PRESENT.

In accordance with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), State of Arizona, and HOA Board of Directors, all residents are required to follow these guidelines.

- If sick, go home. Do not enter.
- Visitors and guests are not allowed entry.
- If you are at higher risk for severe illness, you should avoid this area. People at higher risk for severe illness include adults 65 or older and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions.
- Wash hands with soap and water.
- Use hand sanitizer if soap and water is unavailable.
- Wash/sanitize hands before, during, and after play.
- Maintain a minimum six feet social distancing from other residents at all times.
- Utilize a cloth facial covering or mask but masks are not a substitute for staying six feet away from others.
- Do not touch your eyes, nose, or mouth.
- Bring your own water bottle, tissues, and hand sanitizer.
- HOURS ARE 10:00 A.M. UNTIL 4:00 P.M. MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY. LIBRARY IS CLOSED SATURDAY AND SUNDAY.
- MAXIMUM ATTENDEES IS SIX (6) INDIVIDUALS PLUS A VOLUNTEER HOSTESS.
- USAGE TIME IS LIMITED TO THIRTY (30) MINUTES PER VISIT.
- TWO DESKTOP COMPUTERS ARE AVAILABLE FOR USE BY RESIDENTS.
- THE PUZZLE TABLE AND LAPTOP TABLE ARE UNAVAILABLE AT THIS TIME.
- PUZZLES SHOULD BE TAKEN HOME TO COMPLETE.
- A FACIAL MASK AND GLOVES ARE RECOMMENDED.
- HOURS ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.
- GUIDELINES ARE SUBJECT TO REVIEW AND REVISION AS NECESSARY.
